

PATIENT MAKES CONTACT WITH CHIROPRACTIC CLINIC

Chiropractor performs a remote risk assessment consultation; ask the patient about chief complaints and previous medical history. Rule out potential RED FLAGS and cases beyond the Chiropractic scope of practice

Patient has suspected serious pathology that is beyond the Chiropractic scope of practice

Based upon remote Chiropractic consultation you are unclear if serious pathology can be ruled in/out based on level of assessment

No serious pathology suspected

Refer to GP and/or A&E for follow up and/or emergency care as per our normal Chiropractic practice procedures

Consider Chiropractic care if the patient has medical need or if not addressed, the patient may require GP or other social care assistance. This is relevant for a patient who is a key worker or carer for vulnerable or elderly individuals

Offer a face to face Chiropractic consultation, after a remote risk assessment triage for potential Covid 19 risk. Follow all PPE and PHE directives

Urgent care not necessary

Serious pathology suspected

Serious pathology not suspected – manage medical need

Face to face Chiropractic visit not clinically indicated

Offer remote Chiropractic advice and self management as clinically indicated via Telehealth
